Lake Walking in Austria's Salzkammergut

Embark on a journey through the Salzkammergut, which could not be more varied.

Details about the hiking holiday in the Salzkammergut

Explore the most beautiful villages on the glistening Wolfgangsee: St. Wolfgang, St. Gilgen and Strobl. Later, the trail takes you to Bad Ischl and Bad Goisern before you finally arrive in the historic Hallstatt. Lake Hallstatt also invites you to cool off in its crystal-clear water on warm summer days.

Highlights of the hiking tour in the Salzkammergut at a glance:

- **Swim in crystal clear water:** The Wolfgangsee and Lake Hallstatt are two of the most enchanting waters in the entire Salzkammergut. Take a dip in the cool water...
- **Take the Schafbergbahn to a panoramic view:** Experience the lake-scattered landscape from above. From the Schafberg, the view is second to none.
- **Visit the Imperial Villa and the Hotel Austria:** Where Emperor Franz Josef and Elisabeth of Bavaria (beloved Austrian royalty in the 1800s) got engaged.

- **Salt mine of Hallstatt:** Immerse yourself in the history of salt mining and take part in an exciting

Arrival at lake Wolfgangsee

Round trip St. Wolfgang & St. Gilgen

Take the boat to St. Wolfgang. On your walk along a walking trail to Falkenstein rock wall you enjoy beautiful views of the lake. An idyllic path along the lake takes you into Mozart village St. Gilgen. Return by boat.

Wolfgangsee – Bad Ischl

From St. Wolfgang on Saddle walk to lake Schwarzensee. Here the lake cabin of Lore is worth a stop for the delicious home made snacks. Via Wirer gorge into the valley and around Bürglstein to the lake promenade of Strobl. By coach into the ancient Imperial summer residence Bad Ischl.

Use your free time to explore the many places of interest in Bad Ischl. 'Kaiservilla' Emperor Franz Josef's summer residence, Café Zauner with famous delicacies or a visit to the Salzkammergut thermal spa.

DAY
5*Bad Ischl – Bad Goisern*

Salt always has been an important source of income in Salzkammergut. The oldest brine pipeline of the world leads from Hallstatt's salt mine to the salt works in Bad Ischl. Walk along the promenade into Kaltenbachau, a site of Imperial pleasures as horse races, picnics and rendezvous. On brine pipeline trail to Bad Goisern, the gateway to UNESCO heritage Hallstatt. If you want to walk a little higher, you can hike on the spectacular mountain trail of the "Eternal Wall".

6*Round trip Hallstatt*

Continue on brine pipeline trail to the salt mountain in Hallstatt (salt mine dates back to Celtic times). Here you enjoy a scenic view of the lake and Dachstein massif. Plan a visit of the salt mine, enjoy the views from the top of Rudolf's tower and visit the excavation sites. A boat carries you across the lake back to Bad Goisern.

7*Bad Goisern – Wolfgangsee*

By train to Bad Ischl. Along the romantic Sissi-Path you walk to the tiny lake Nussensee then along river Ischl back to lake Wolfgangsee. Through the nature reserve Blinkingmoos along the lake back to today's stop-over.

Infos

Arrival / Parking / Departure:

- By train to Salzburg, by bus to Wolfgangsee (approx. 1 hour). Or by train to Bad Ischl and by bus to Wolfgangsee (approx. 30 min). Pick up service from the bus stop by the hotel.
- Parking: mostly free hotel car park available, partly public car park, approx. EUR 30 per week. No reservation required.

Things to note:

- Tourist tax, if due, is not included in the price
- Bus ride Strobl – Bad Ischl, approx. EUR 4 per person are not included
