## Ridge walk Julian Alps

FASCINATING MOUNTAIN LANDSCAPE.

This diversified walking tour leads along crests, wonderful ridge walks and through lush green valleys. You cross the Julian Alps with the well-known Triglav massif and the highest Slovenian mountain with an altitude of 2.864 m. Again and again you come to comfortable huts with typical charm. The climate is really pleasant in this region, nearly already Mediterranean. You walk through diversity flora and alpine scenery. Enjoy the breathtaking views onto the panorama paths. A highlight of the journey is Bohinj Lake, which is framed through steep and cliffy mountain peaks. On your walking week an interesting combination from mountains, rural villages and interesting villages like Bled is awaiting you.

## *Arrival in Bled*

Idyllic Bled with deep-blue lake and Triglav national park is inviting for an exploration in the evening. You should taste the regional cuisine.

## *Bled – Pokljuka high plateau*

Transfer to Mrzli Studenec at Pokljuka high plateau (1.280 m) – starting point of many walking tours in the Julian Alps. Your first walk leads through spruce forests and broad alpine meadows. Climb to Lipanška koča hut and stop for a tasty meal. In the afternoon walking tour on a panorama path.

## *Pokljuka high plateau – Planika hut*





Today you reach the heart of the Julian Alps – at the foot of the highest peak in Slovenia, onto Triglav. Along a slightly climb up to Vodnik hut. Aim of the day is Planika hut, located directly at the south wall of Triglav. The hut is ideal starting point for a climb onto Triglav (additional night and alpine experience necessary!).

## *Planika hut – Seven Lakes mountain hut*





Walk over the Hribarice pass (2.358 m) in direction Triglav Lakes. Enjoy the wonderful beauty of the seven lakes in Triglav national park. Along a broad path a wonderful view over the valley with its lakes is awaiting you.

## *Seven lakes mountain hut – Komna hut*

Hike further to the West, where you will soon reach the lake Schwarzsee, the deepest lake of the Triglav lakes. The lake is warm and has a unique flora and fauna. You can enjoy a beautiful view of Lake Bohinj from your overnight accommodation, Komna hut.

## *Komna hut – Ribčev Laz*

From Komna you walk along the old military street to waterfall Savica, a well-known and popular waterfall in Slovenia. An alpine karst spring feeds the waterfall which has a length of 78 m and runs into mighty Bohinj Lake. Short walk along the waterside. In the summer the lake invites for a bath in crystal-clear water. You stay overnight at the eastern bank of the lake, in the friendly village of Ribčev Laz. Try one of the local bars with tasty mead or homemade snaps.

## *Ribčev Laz – Bled*

Transfer to Lake Bled. The surrounding offers a huge variety for walking tours, we recommend doing a walk through Vintgar gorge. A 1.600 m long wooden path is awaiting you, it leads through the worth-seeing gorge along river Radovna and to Sum waterfall. Or you explore Lake Bled within a loop tour and at a journey by rowboat to the popular island church.

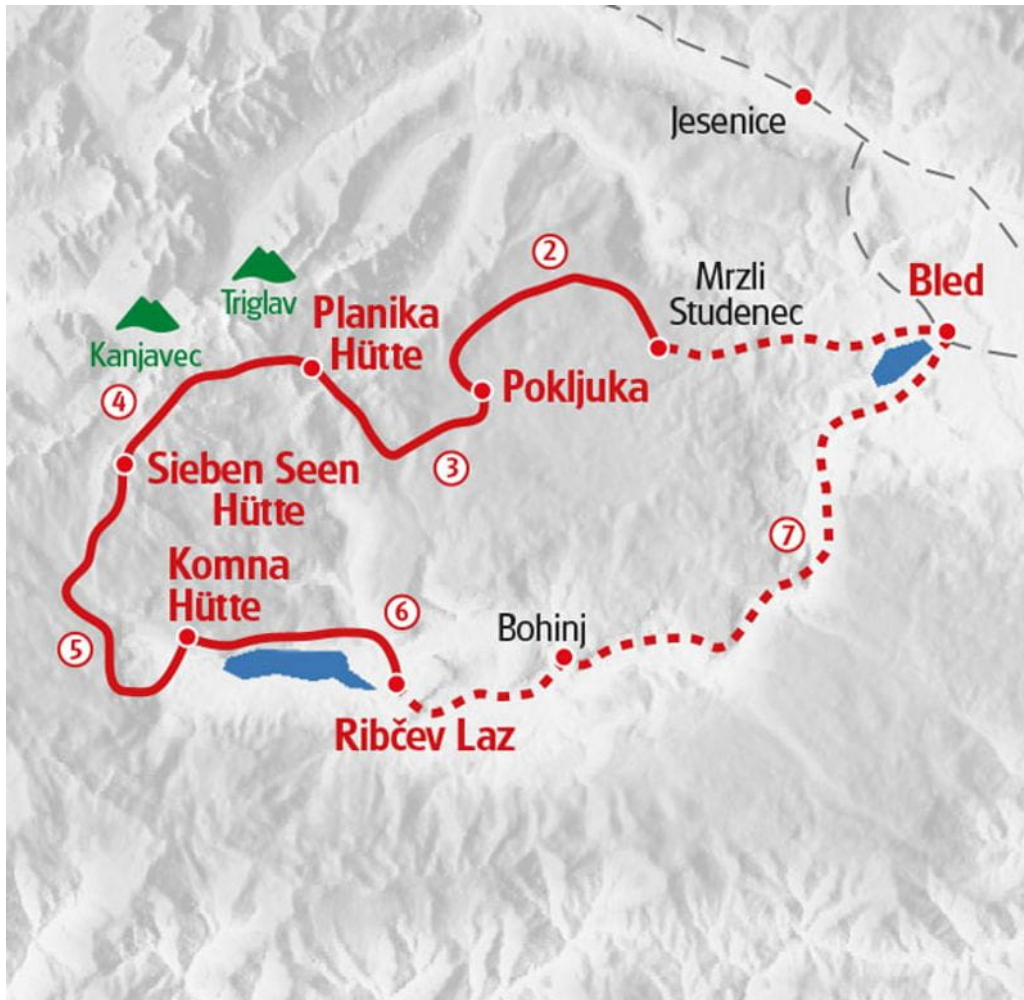

For all transfers a reservation is required, payable in advance.

## Info

### Arrival / Parking / Departure:

- Airport Ljubljana and by bus in about 1 hour to Bled or airport Klagenfurt and by train in approx. 3 hours to Bled
- Train arrival via Villach or Jesenice to Bled.
- Parking: limited number of hotel parking spaces. Public or guarded parking spaces near the hotel approx. EUR 40 to EUR 70 per week.

### Things to note:



- Entrance fees approx. EUR 50 and detailed mountain hiking map for the area Triglav National Park approx. EUR 10, payable on spot.
- Single rooms are only available during hotel stays
